

## Sunday, February 22

### Departure

## Monday, February 23

### Arrival | Rome's Greatest Sites

#### ARRIVAL IN ROME

Meet ProRome Tour Manager and board private transfer to Donna Camilla Savelli Hotel. Check-in with time to settle in and freshen up. Located in the heart of the Eternal City, this former baroque monastery is now one of Rome's finest four-star hotels. This oasis of beauty is hidden from over-tourism, tucked away by the narrow alleyways of Trastevere, Rome's favorite neighborhood, with restaurants, bars and enotecas at arm's reach.

#### AFTERNOON - CENTRO STORICO

Introductory private tour of some of Rome's most famous sites; Transportation

by Mercedes van, featuring door to door service. The tour navigates the historic center of Rome, exploring some of the city's most beloved and photographed places. Churches abound here; San Luigi dei Francesi and Sant'Agostino house some of Caravaggio's striking artwork; the Roman Pantheon was consecrated as the church of Santa Maria ad Martyres in the year 609 and is one of the greatest buildings ever constructed. It is the only fully intact building of Roman antiquity, a masterpiece of engineering - but no architecture degree is required to appreciate its simple geometric beauty. A few meters away is Piazza Navona, the "stage" for Bernini's famed Fountain of Four Rivers. Other dramatic piazzas showcase the Trevi Fountain and the Spanish Steps. Additional destinations are several of the city's most celebrated and magnificent churches, such as the Gesu` and Sant'Ignazio, which inspire awe and consolation.

## Tuesday, February 24

### Colosseum | Optional Tours

#### MORNING - ANCIENT ROME

Underground Tour of Rome including: the arena floor of the world's greatest amphitheater, the Colosseum (VIP Gladiator Colosseum Experience), the Crypt of San Clemente and the Roman houses beneath the Basilica Santi Giovanni e Paolo.

#### AFTERNOON - EARLY CHRISTIAN ROME

Free Time OR an OPTIONAL visit to Rome's greatest artistic and archeological treasures of early Christianity, its 4th and 5th century basilicas, each of which has a unique story to tell:

#### **Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls.**

Saint Paul Outside the Walls is built over the tomb of Saint Paul, which is now visible from the confessio. A tour of the basilica will recall the story of Saint Paul, his martyrdom and burial, as well as the fascinating history of this church that was consecrated in the year 402 and was almost lost to a fire in 1823.

**Basilica of Saint Mary Major.** To tour Saint Mary Major is to venerate some of Rome's most precious sacred relics: the icon of Madonna Salus Populi Romani

(Rome's most important, miraculous, Marian image), the Manger in which Christ was born, and the and the tomb of Pope Saint Pius V, whose body is incorrupt. Adorning the nave of St. Mary Major are the world's oldest preserved Early Christian mosaics, dating to the church's construction in the 5th century.

**Basilica of St. John Lateran.** Built by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century, and dedicated to Christ the Savior, this church is known as the "Mater et Caput" - the mother and head of all the churches of the world. It was the seat of the Bishop of Rome upon Constantine's legalization of Christianity, and has remained so ever since.

## Wednesday, February 25

### Borghese Gallery | Outdoor Excursion

#### MORNING - BORGHESE GALLERY

A guided tour of the stunning Borghese Gallery by art historian Liz Lev. (TBD) The Borghese is a small but spectacular museum that holds some of the most important artworks of High Renaissance and Baroque Rome, such as paintings by Caravaggio and sculptures by Bernini, including Apollo and Daphne.

#### AFTERNOON - OUTDOOR EXCURSION

Day trip to either hike the Via Sacra or to go horseback riding in the Castelli.

An OPTIONAL World War II Tour of the Jewish Ghetto.


#### AFTERNOON - ITALIAN COOKING CLASS

Michelangelo's ceiling masterpiece depicts scenes from the book of Genesis, including Creation of Adam. On the altar wall, Michelangelo painted the greatest Last Judgment in the history of art. The Vatican Museums house the world's greatest collections of Early Christian, Medieval and Renaissance art.

## **Friday, February 27** **Day Trip To Orvieto**

### **MORNING & AFTERNOON - ORVIETO**

Day Trip to Orvieto and the Cathedral, St. Patrick's Well and to enjoy a wine tasting. Orvieto is a beautiful Italian hill town, famous for its medieval cathedral with one of the most exquisite facades in Italy: Duomo di Orvieto. A wonderful curiosity found at Orvieto is St. Patrick's Well: During the Sack of Rome in 1527, Pope Clement VII came to Orvieto. He was worried about the city's water supply and ordered the well built to ensure constant water to the city. The shaft of the deep well is encircled by ramps that enabled donkeys to access and carry the water. A beautiful Wine Tasting is a must in Orvieto, famous for its excellent Orvieto Classico white wine.

## **Saturday, February 28** **St. Peter's Basilica | Scavi Tour**

### **MORNING - ST. PETER'S BASILICA**

The Greatest Building in the World: Tour of St. Peter's Basilica with Liz Lev (TBD). The incomparable history and marvels of St. Peter's Basilica will be revealed in a guided tour of this, the greatest church in the world, built over the tomb of St. Peter himself. Michelangelo designed the immense and graceful dome, the cupola of St. Peter's Basilica. There is the option to climb to the top of the dome for the most singularly incredible view looking out over Rome!

### **AFTERNOON - SCAVI TOUR**

Free Time OR OPTIONAL Scavi Tour. The Scavi (excavations) under St. Peter's wind through the actual streets of the ancient Roman cemetery where St. Peter was buried following his martyrdom in Nero's circus. The unique subterranean tour takes the visitor right to St. Peter's tomb. The cemetery was filled in by Constantine so that the basilica honoring Peter and marking his grave could be built over it. This tour may be moved to a different day and is pending ticket availability.
