A Jubilee Pilgrimage to Italy Join Fr. Joel Sember & Deacon Todd Raether with St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church and the Catholic Parishes of Antigo, WI

This pilgrimage features two nights in Siena, two nights in Assisi, two nights in San Giovanni Rotondo, and three nights in Rome with day-trips to Orvieto and Lanciano along the way. Daily Mass - the cornerstone of each day - will be complemented by a touring program that will immerse the pilgrims in the incredible history, heritage and relics of our Catholic Faith. Highlights include an Audience with the Holy Father in Saint Peter's Square, the Papal Basilicas of Rome, the Duomo of Orvieto, the Basilicas of Saint Francis and Saint Clare in Assisi and the Sanctuary of St. Michael.

Roundtrip airfare and centrally-located four star hotels (TBD) will be arranged. A ProRome tour manager will accompany the group throughout the course of the pilgrimage, and private bus transportation, Catholic tour guides, all tours and tickets, daily breakfast and daily dinner are included in the price.

Monday, September 15 **Departure**

Tuesday, September 16 **Arrival | Orvieto | Siena**

Upon arrival in Rome we will meet our tour guide and driver and depart immediately for Siena. On the way there we will stop in the beautiful hilltop city of Orvieto, home to one of Italy's finest Gothic cathedrals, the Duomo of Orvieto. The Duomo serves as a solemn reliquary for the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena, the first Church-approved Eucharistic miracle and the impetus behind the institution of the Feast of Corpus Christi! Here we will have Mass and a private tour followed by free time for lunch.

After enjoying free time in Orvieto we are back on the bus and headed to Siena. Upon arrival in Siena we will check in at our four-star hotel (TBD) where we will enjoy a welcome dinner before heading off to bed.

Wednesday, September 17 **Siena**

Following breakfast we will enjoy a walking tour through the incredible city of Siena, found in the heart of the Chianti region of Tuscany. Here we will explore the life and legacy of Saint Catherine of Siena, the great mystic and Doctor of the Church. Saint Catherine helped to restore the faith of the people of Europe following the 14th century Black Death, through her incredible preaching, miracle work and mission to bring the Pope back to Rome. Our morning tour in Siena features the Basilica of San Domenico (where we will have Mass), the Sanctuary House of Saint Catherine and the Basilica of San Francesco, which is home to a Eucharistic miracle.

Following our morning tour the group will enjoy free time for lunch in the Piazza del Campo, Italy's most celebrated medieval square known for the famous "Palio," a horse race in which ten of Siena's neighborhoods send a jockey and a horse to compete in a bareback race three times around the square. We will then rendezvous for an afternoon tour through the Duomo of Siena, one of Europe's greatest Cathedrals which is full of incredible works of sacred art. We will then return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, September 18 **Assisi**

Following breakfast we will depart for Assisi. Prior to reaching the medieval city center of Assisi we will visit the original home of the Franciscan Order, and the place of St. Francis's death at the Porziuncola Chapel inside the great Baroque Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels. Here we will have Mass and a tour. Following the tour we will proceed to Assisi and check-in at our four-star hotel (TBD). There will then be free time for lunch.

After lunch we will enjoy a guided tour of the Basilica of Saint Francis with a Franciscan friar. Throughout this tour we will be immersed in the life of Saint Francis of Assisi, learning his story from birth to death through the great medieval artwork of Giotto and Cimabue that decorates this 13th century basilica. We will then return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Friday, September 19 **Assisi**

Today begins with Mass in the Basilica of St. Francis at the tomb of Saint Francis. We will then enjoy a guided tour of Assisi, which

includes visits to the Basilica of Santa Clara, the Cathedral of San Rufino, the church of Saint Mary Major (where Bl. Carlo Acutis is buried), and many other sacred churches and burial sites found throughout the Seraphic City. On this tour you will explore the life and legacy of Saint Francis and Saint Clare, walking in their footsteps and praying at their tombs.

In the afternoon there will be free time for shopping, or for an optional hike up into the mountains to the very place where St. Francis first fled from the world -The Hermitage of Assisi. In the evening we will enjoy a group dinner at Il Medioevo, one of Assisi's most characteristic restaurants.

Saturday, September 20 **Lanciano | San Giovanni Rotondo**

Following an early breakfast we will begin a three-hour bus ride to Lanciano, the site of a Eucharistic Miracle that took place in the 8th century to a monk who doubted Christ's true presence in the Eucharist. Following the prayers of Consecration, this monk watched as the host was changed into living flesh and the wine was changed into living blood, which coagulated into five balls, irregular and differing in shape and size. Scientific studies have proven that this is in fact living human flesh, muscular tissue from the heart.

After Mass and lunch, a two-hour bus ride takes us to San Giovanni Rotondo, where we will check in at the four-star Hotel Gran Paradiso. Here we will enjoy a welcome dinner together.

Sunday, September 21 **San Giovanni Rotondo | The Sanctuary Of Saint Michael**

Our day begins with Mass and a tour of San Giovanni Rotondo. We will visit the friary where Padre Pio lived and worked many miracles. Our tour will conclude with a visit to the incorrupt body of St. Padre Pio. After lunch we take an afternoon trip to the nearby Sanctuary of St. Michael the Archangel, a medieval sanctuary built into the rocky summit of a mountain overlooking the Adriatic Sea. In the 5th century, when Barbarian invasions were unsettling many parts of the European continent, the local bishop saw a miraculous apparition of St. Michael on this site. For over a thousand years it has been one of the most important pilgrimage sites in Europe. We will then return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Holy Mass: San Giovanni Rotondo

Monday, September 22 **Rome: St Paul Outside The Walls |** **St. Mary Major**

Following breakfast in San Giovanni Rotondo, we will depart for Rome. As we near the walls of Rome, we will stop at the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, the burial place of Saint Paul and the second-largest church in the world, second only to St. Peter's. Here we will celebrate Holy Mass and enjoy a guided tour of this incredible relic of early Christianity.

Following our tour we will depart for the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major, one of the greatest churches in the world and still standing from the 5th century! On our tour of Saint Mary Major we will be able to venerate many sacred relics, such as the Manger in which Christ was born, the Madonna Salus Populi Romani (Rome's most important Marian image) and the tomb of Pope Saint Pius V. We will then check in to our beautiful four-star hotel for dinner and overnight.

Tuesday, September 23 **Rome: St. Peter's Basilica | The Lateran |** **Holy Stairs | Basilica Of The Holy Cross** **In Jerusalem**

Our first day in Rome begins with a visit to St. Peter's Basilica, where we have Mass followed by a tour of the greatest church in the world -

built over the tomb of St. Peter himself. Following the tour there will be free time for lunch in the lovely Borgo Pio neighborhood of Rome, adjacent to the Vatican City. After lunch we will depart for the Cathedral of Rome, "The Lateran." Built by Constantine in the 4th century, this church is known as the "Mater et Caput" - the mother and head of all the churches in the entire world, as it officially became the seat of the Bishop of Rome upon the legalization of Christianity under the Emperor Constantine the Great. Following our tour everyone will have the opportunity to climb the Holy Stairs - the very stairs that Christ once walked in the Praetorium of Pontius Pilate. The stairs must be climbed on one's knees out of respect for our Lord and the suffering He endured. We will then walk down the street to venerate the most Holy Relics of Christ's Passion, including a large relic of the True Cross, kept in the Basilica of Holy Cross in Jerusalem. We will then return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, September 24 **Papal Audience | Vatican Museums &** **Sistine Chapel**

Following an early morning Mass at the Church of San Lorenzo in Piscibus, we will attend an Audience with the Holy Father in Saint Peter's Square. Make sure to bring religious articles, which the Pope will bless at the conclusion of the Audience! After free




